Meeting called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Marty Ordinans

1. All in attendance were introduced and welcomed.
2. Minutes from August 12, 2010 meeting reviewed. Motion to approve minutes made and seconded. Motion carried.
3. Review of treasurer's report by Frank Windt. From July 1, 2010 to September 9, 2010 we had an income of \$7,958.68 for a total income of \$44,787.58. Frank reminded everyone that of the \$44,787.58, \$20,000.00 is earmarked for a donation from the Booster Club for a new stadium, etc. Motion made and seconded to approve report. Motion carried. Complete financial statements are available at each WFBC meeting.
4. Superintendent of Whitnall School District: Dr. Lowell Holtz was introduced as the new Superintendent of the Whitnall School District.
5. Funding Requests: None at this time.
6. Administration Report: No report this month.
7. Committee Reports
  - Membership: Kathy Reese reported that 203 memberships have been sold for 2010-2011 vs. 228 for 2009-2010.
    - 185 WFBC memberships with Family Athletic Events Pass
    - 18 WFBC membership onlyKathy commented that including the membership form in the registration packet worked well.
  - Senior athletic banquet: A date for the banquet needs to be determined as well as a discussion on what sport groups should be invited to attend.
  - Post Prom: J. Job will begin working on prom shortly.
  - Whitnall wear: Whitnall wear will be sold at the varsity home games on September 17<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>. It was suggested that Whitnall wear also be sold at the freshman game on Thursday, September 16<sup>th</sup>.
  - Website: The website needs to be updated to reflect the 2010-2011 officers and committee members. B. Stave will update.
  - Awards: No Report
  - Annual Fund Raiser: M. Ordinans reported for T. Wisialowski that the date of the WFBC fundraiser night has been set for Friday, February 26, 2011. It was pointed out that that Friday and Monday are early release and no school days, so many families may be out of town that weekend. The date will be revisited. Venue was also discussed and a Whitnall park location was suggested. A. Schowalter will follow-up for price information, availability, etc. This will be revisited at the October meeting.
  - Concessions: Concession sales are underway for the various athletic events. There are many open slots available for groups to sign up to sell concessions at.

The concession menu has been simplified. At this point, there is no contract with Coca Cola thru the school. A contract can be obtained outside of the school. There are two bad coolers that can be replaced at no charge thru Coca Cola.

- Hospitality: J. Azmani reported that the cakes have been ordered for Thursday, September 23<sup>rd</sup> for the students during lunch hours as part of the homecoming week celebration. Volunteers are being contacted to work the coat room at the homecoming dance. The Booster Club will supply water, soda and juice at the dance.

The Booster Club provided lunch for the freshman class the first day of school.
