Everyday Math: integrated lessons teach beginning math concepts like counting, shapes, sorting, patterning, measurement, and more.

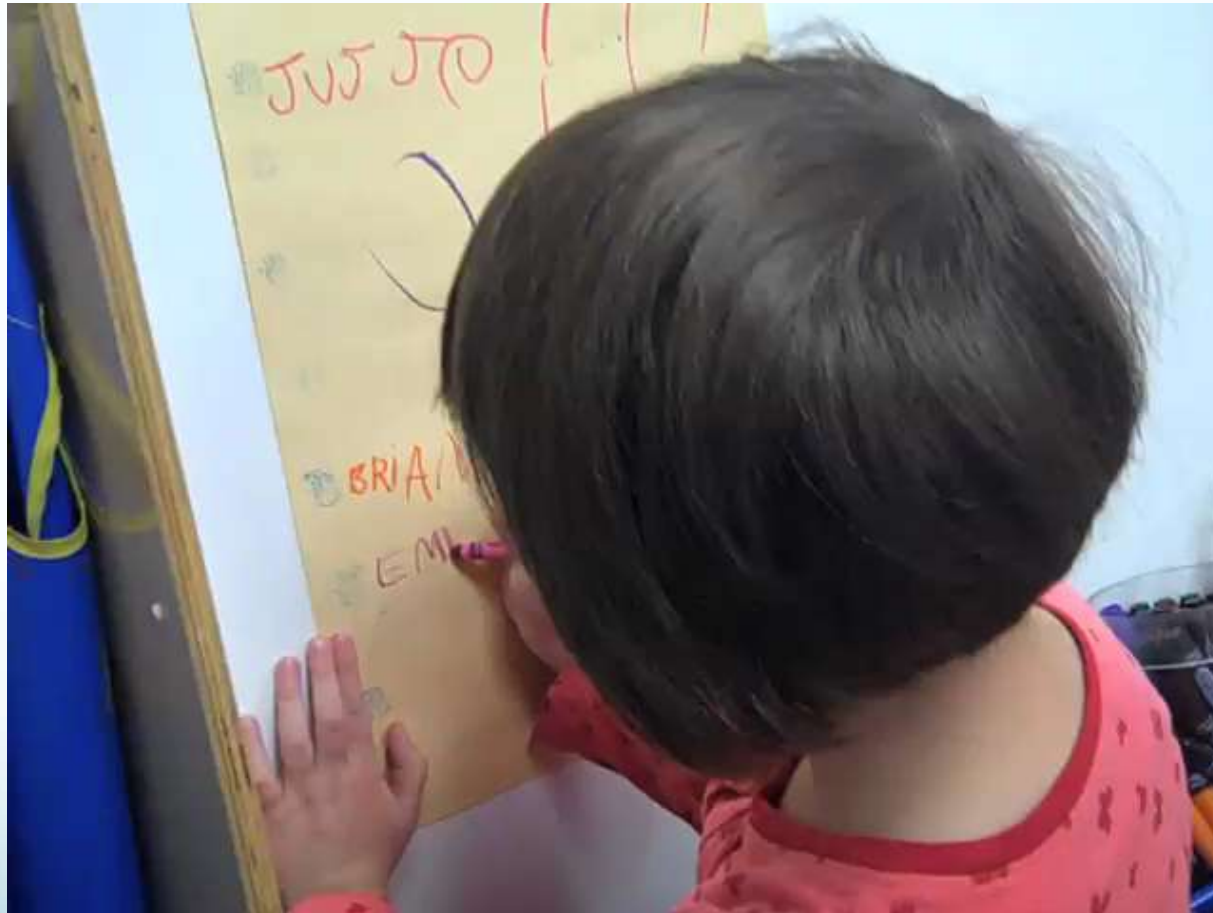
Handwriting Without Tears: multi-sensory handwriting program.



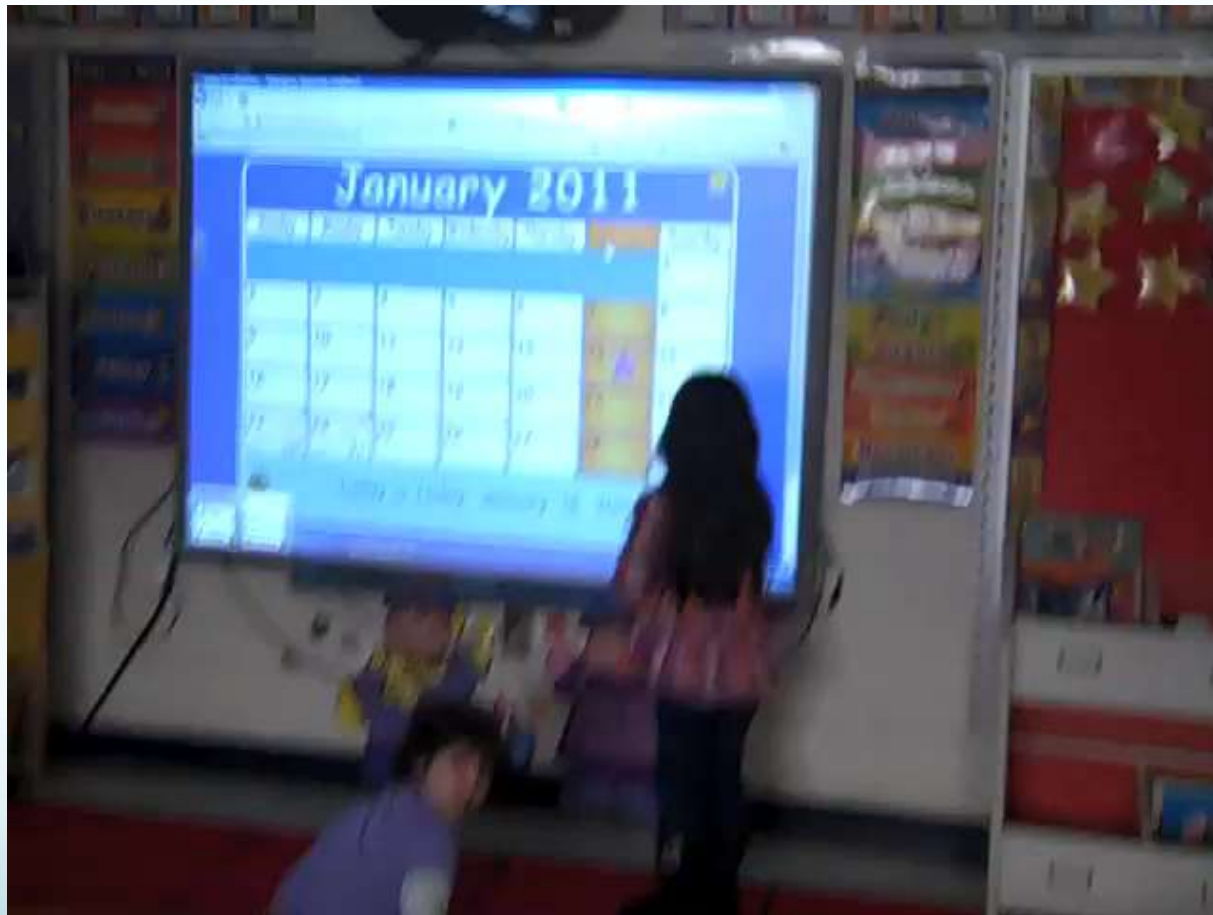

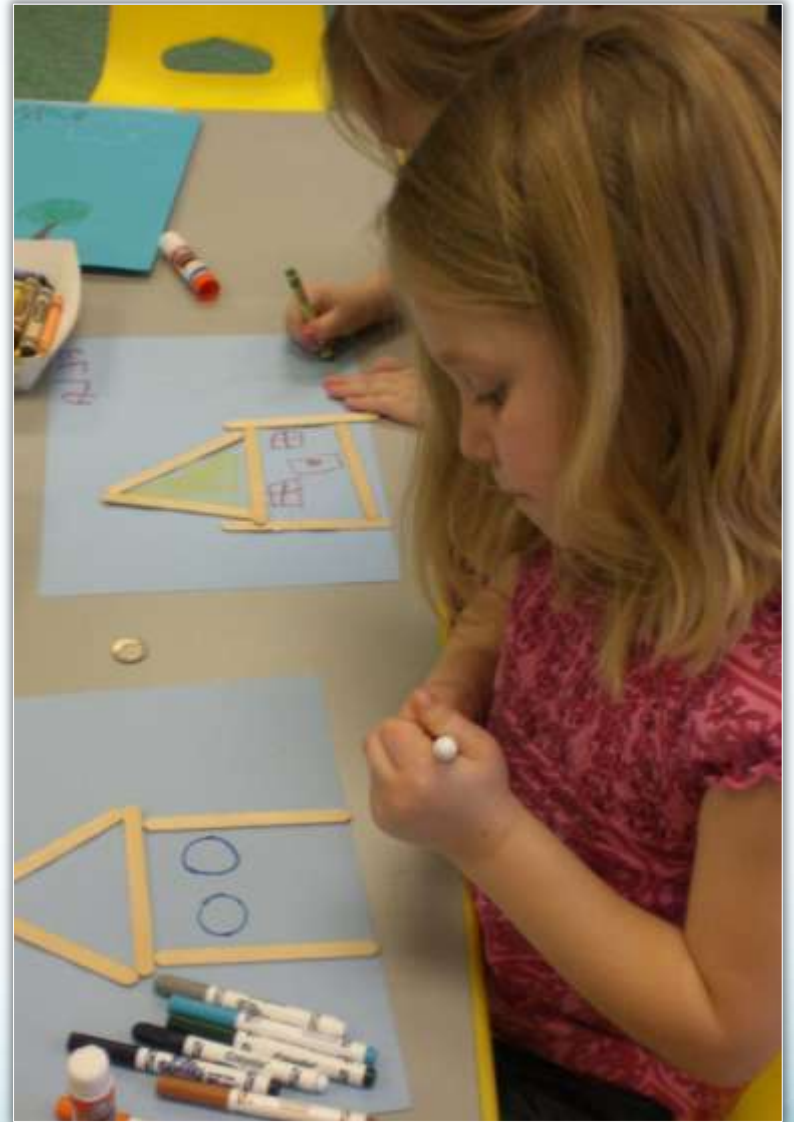

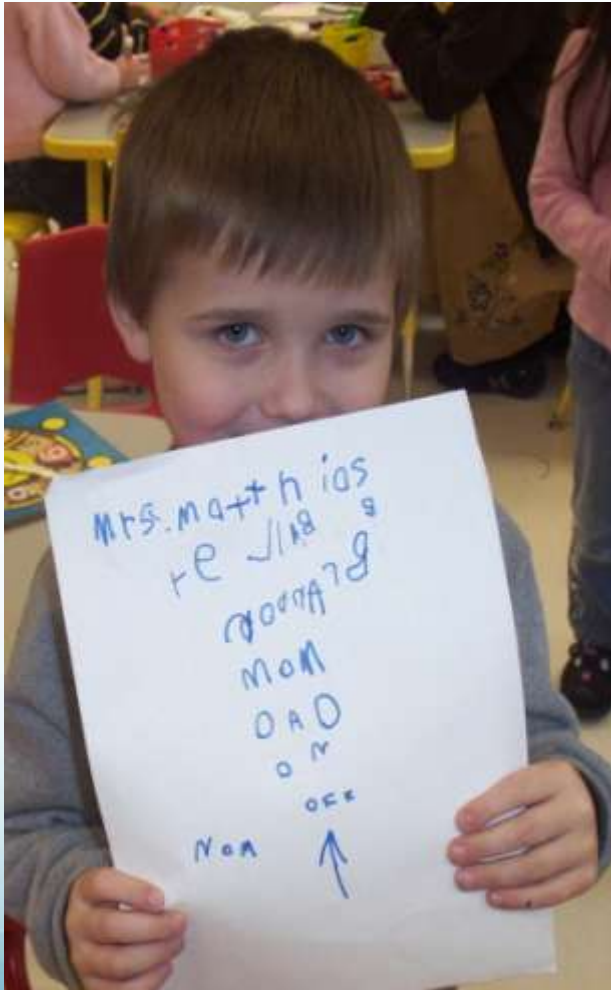
