

## 374/665 FUND RAISING/STUDENT SALES

The School Board recognizes that in certain instances fund raising activities might be necessary to support special types of projects in the District. Such fund raising activities will be kept to a minimum and will need approval from the Superintendent and/or his/her designee.

The School Board also recognizes that fund raising gives students the opportunity to make a contribution to the School District. It can be a positive educational experience if implemented appropriately. It may also create student ownership in the school setting.

Fund raising is intended to supplement the School Board's responsibility to support educational and extra-curricular programming. Students and staff are not to personally benefit from the fund raising.

All funds originating from a school-sponsored fund raising activity under the direct supervision of an agent of the School District shall become the property of the District and are subject to the control and discretion of the School Board and administration as to their use and distribution. Every reasonable effort will be made to insure that funds raised for an approved and specific purpose shall be utilized for that purpose. All fund raising activities shall have prior written approval of the Building Principal and Business Manager. The District does not sanction participation of students in fourth grade or under in door to door sales.

Fundraising activities sponsored by school groups or organizations raising funds for the school or other non-profit organizations requesting use of the school site should seek prior approval of the principal following Board policy on facilities use.
