 - Upload via on line registration
- Students must have a physical exam form that is dated April 1, 2021 or after to be eligible to participate in Athletics and Activities in the 2022-23 school year.

- Complete <u>baseling testing</u> via Athletic Trainer
- Athletic fees will be posted via IC account and must be paid prior to the first day of practice or the student will not be cleared by the Athletic Office. (NEW 2022-2023 school year)

ATTENDANCE AT SCHOOL


- Student-athletes must be in attendance for the FULL school day in order to practice or compete that evening
