<u>ASVAB</u> - For juniors and seniors who are possibly interested in going into the military, you can take the ASVAB test (the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) here at Whitnall High School on Friday, February 2, from 8:00-11:00am in the community/board room. This is a multiple-aptitude battery that measures developed abilities and helps predict future academic and occupational success in the military. It is administered annually to more than one million military applicants, high school, and post-secondary students. For more details, pick up a form in the counseling office. The deadline to register is January 26.

<u>Seniors and the Yearbook</u> - Seniors, although deadlines have passed, you can still get your senior quote in for the yearbook by January 20.
