- Respondents could access the survey online with a one-time-use code

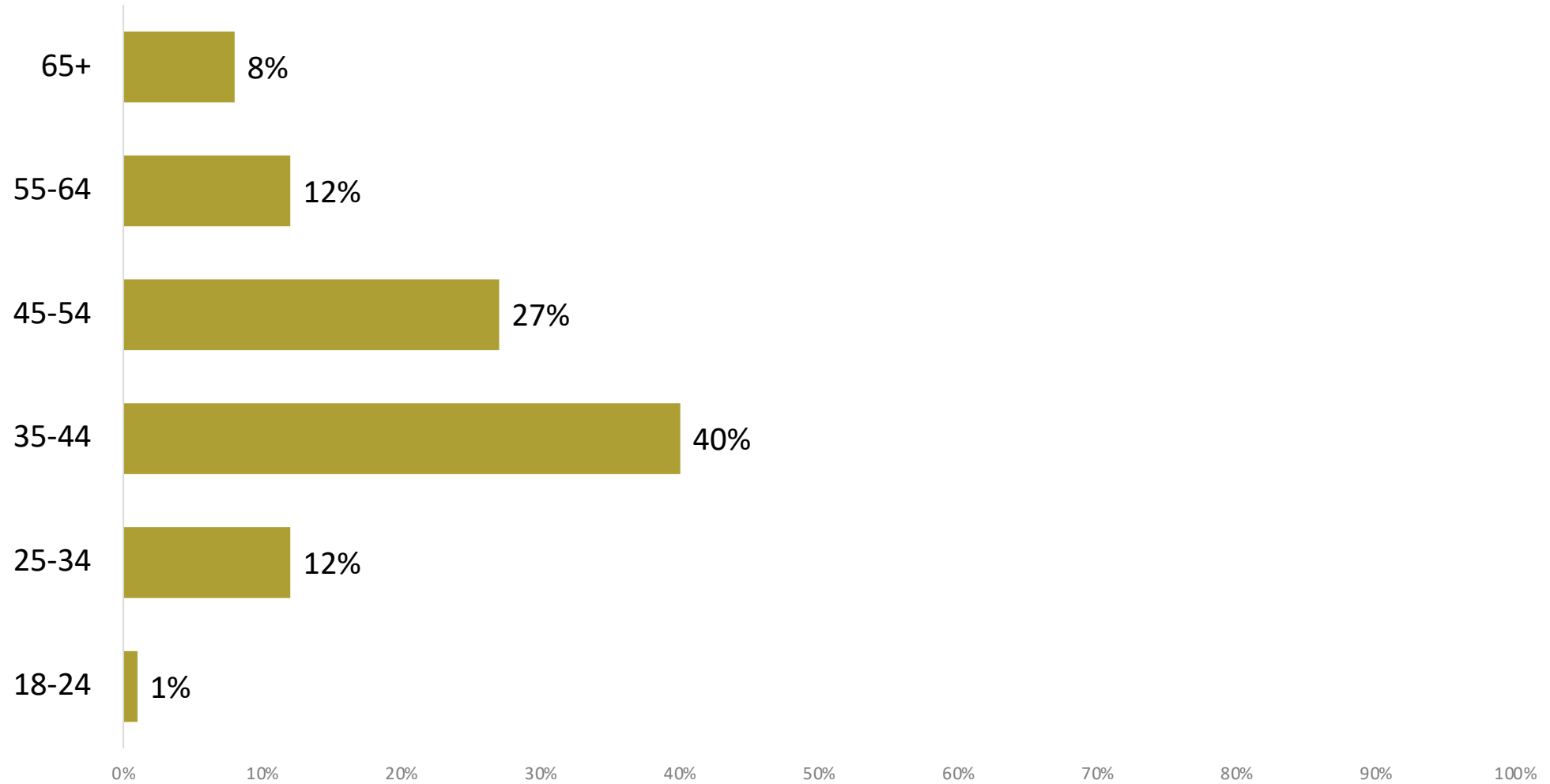
# Survey Information

- +/- **3.54%** margin of error



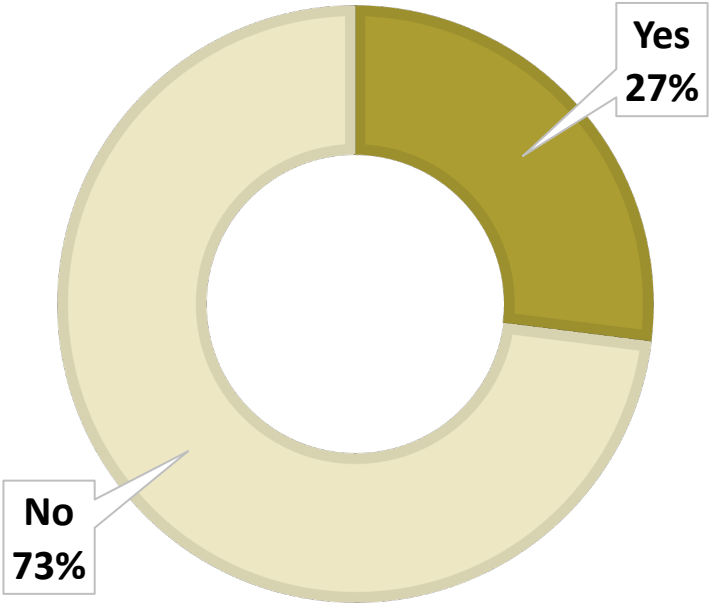
# What is your age?



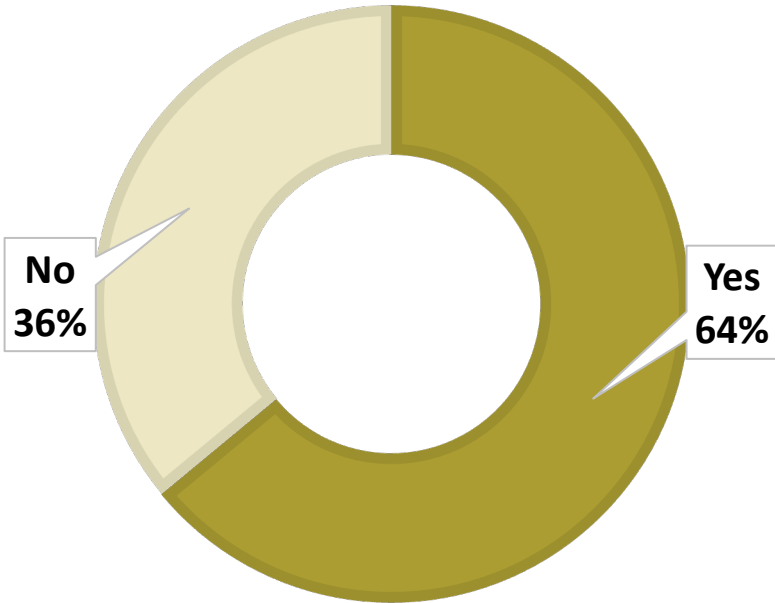

Do you have child(ren) attending school in the District?



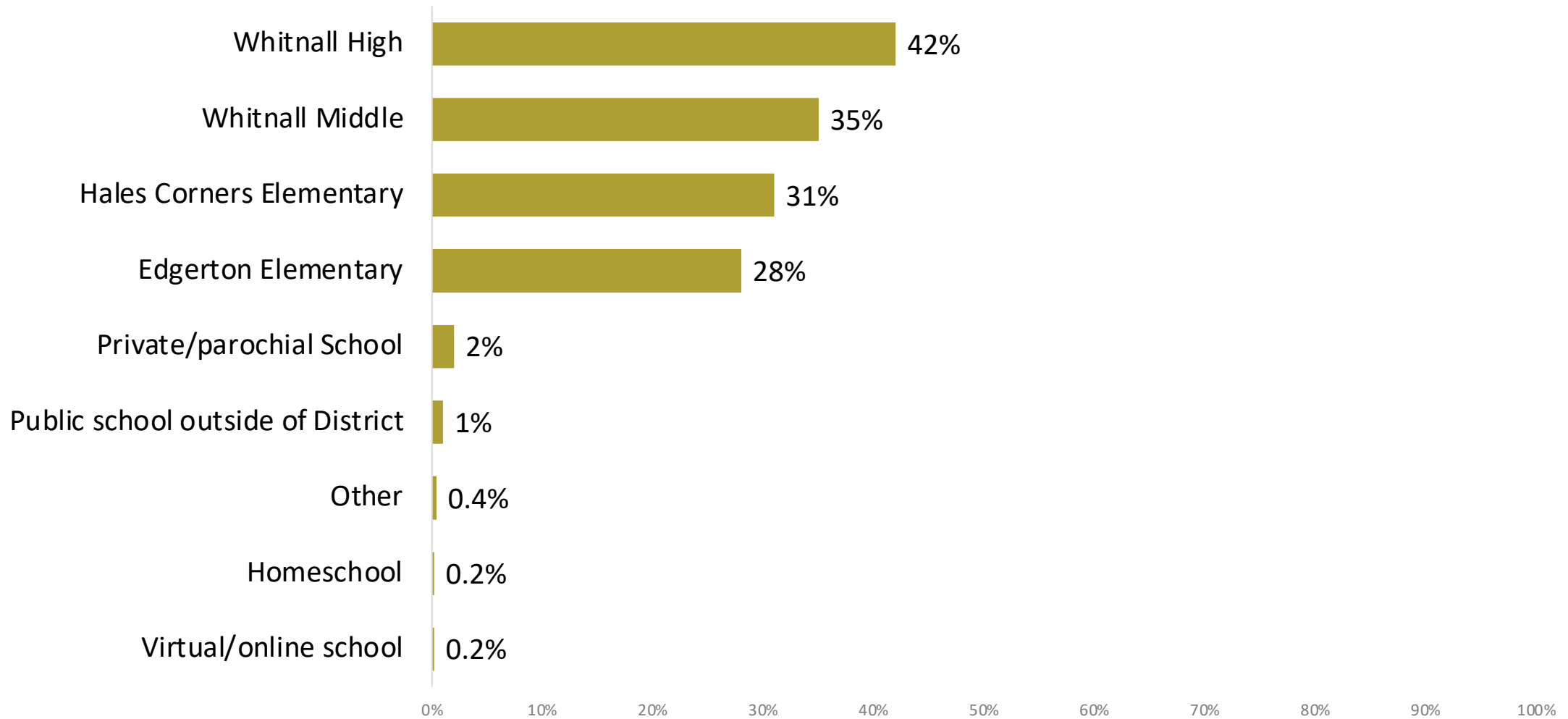


# Parent/Caregiver Demographics

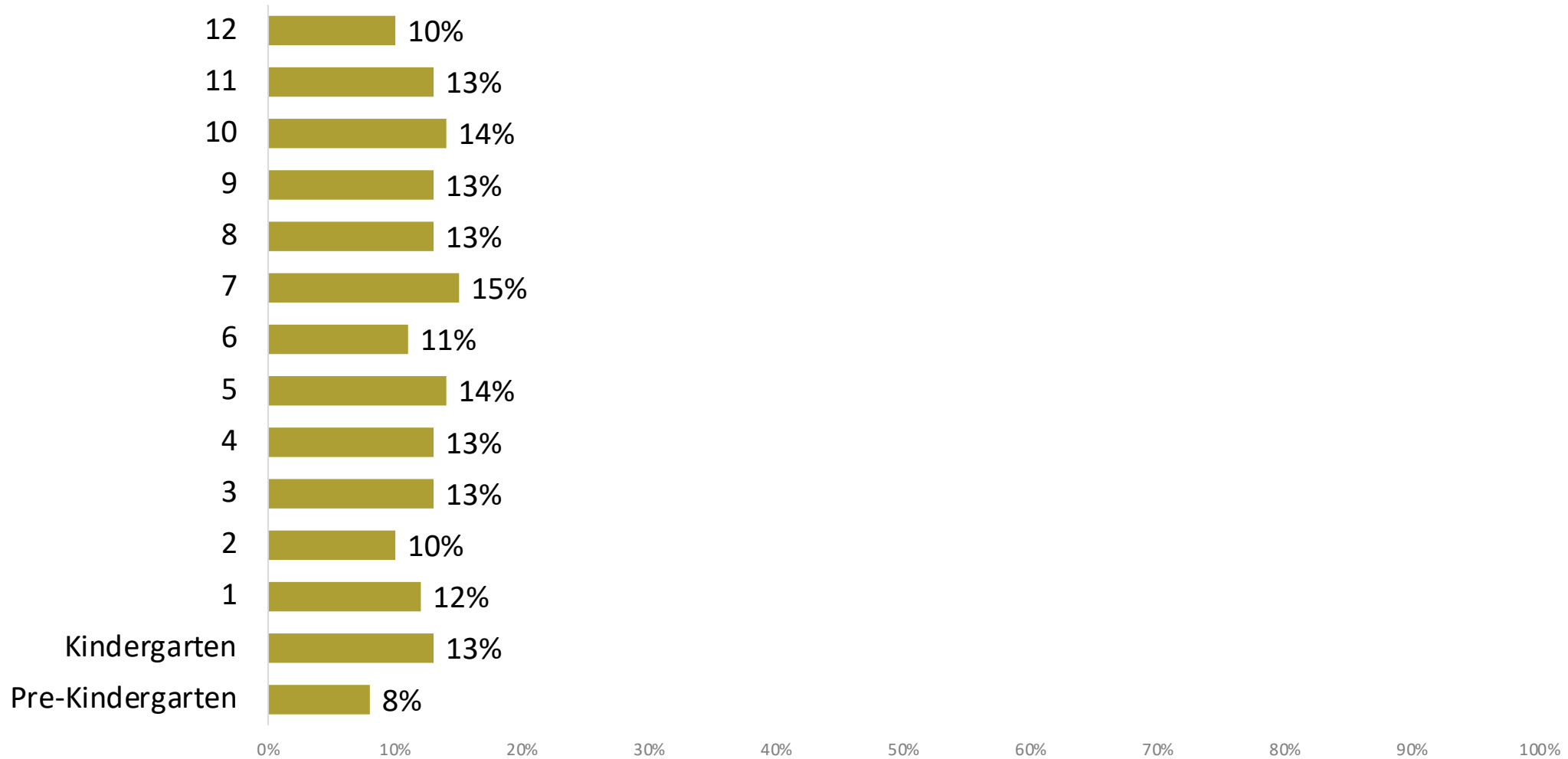




# If you have school-aged children, what school(s) do they attend? *(Mark all that apply.)*

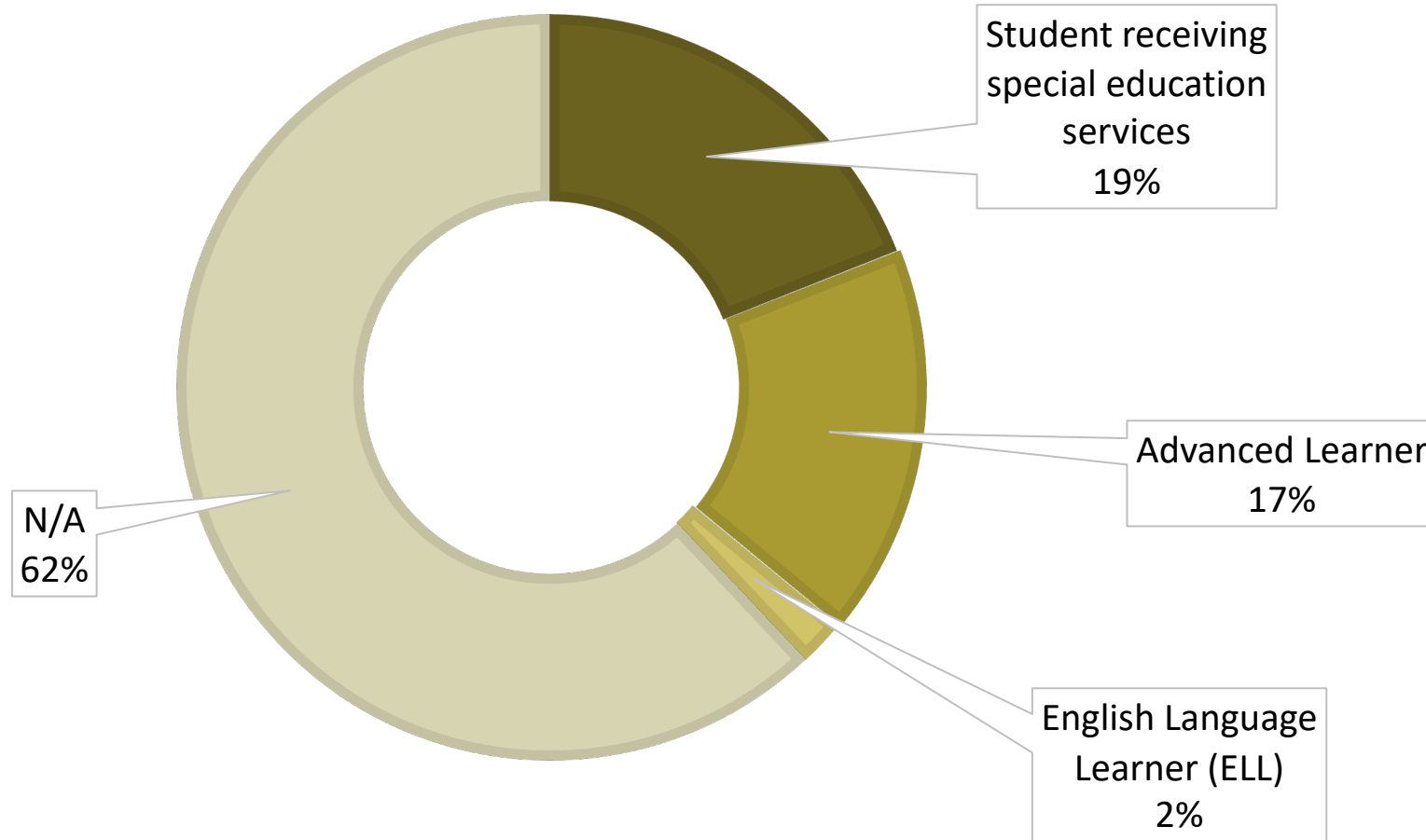


# Grade level of your child(ren) *(Mark all that apply.)*

*(Mark all that apply)*



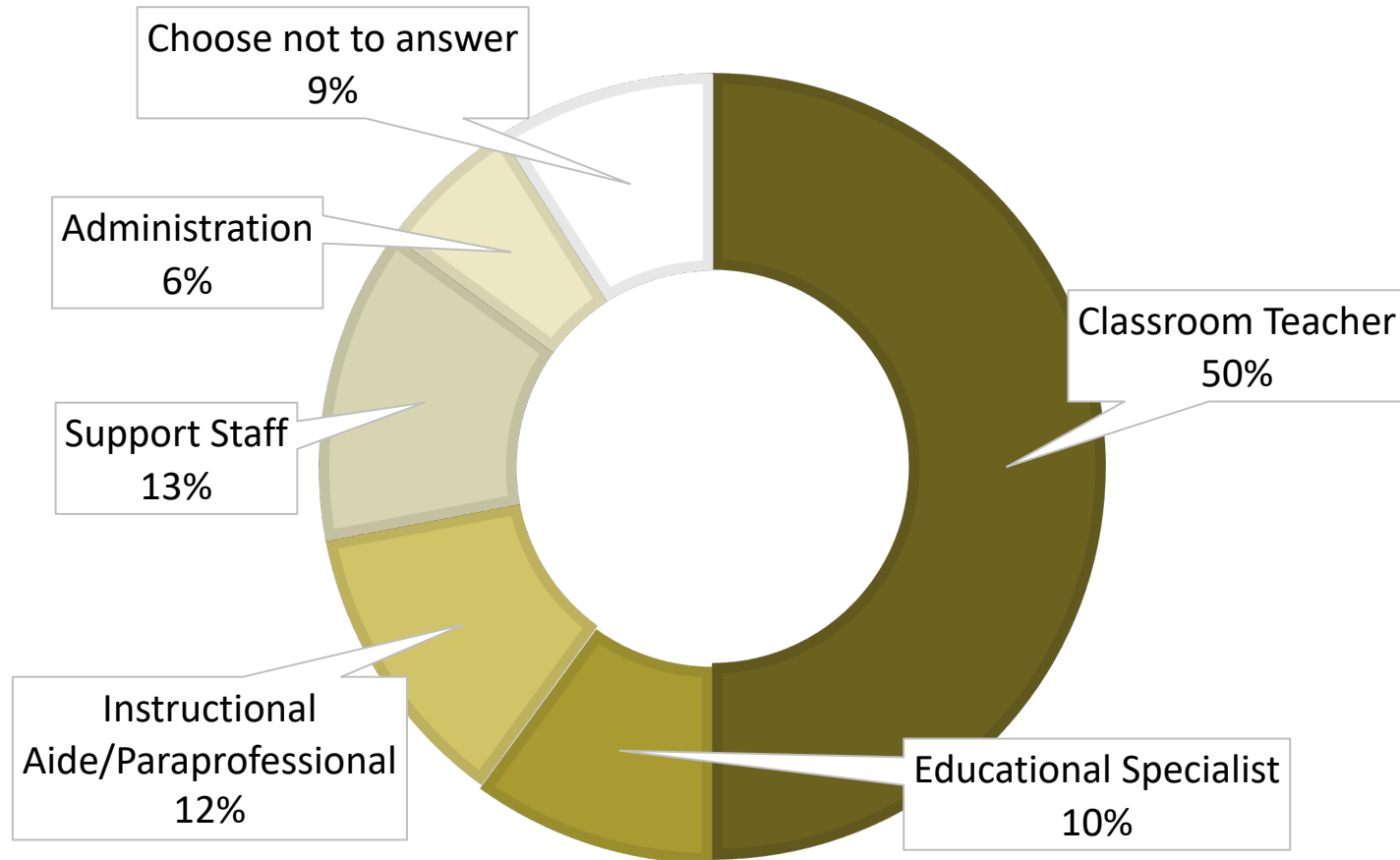

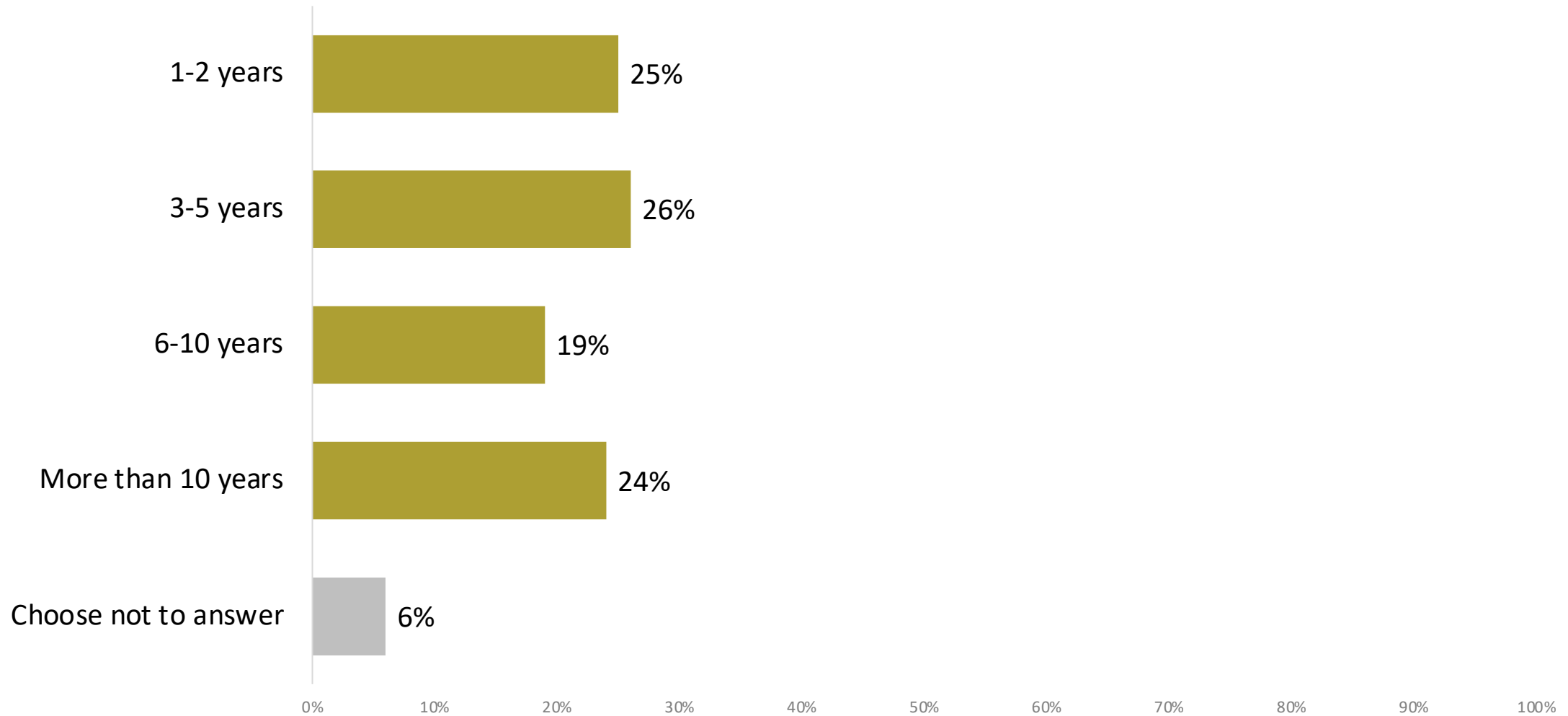




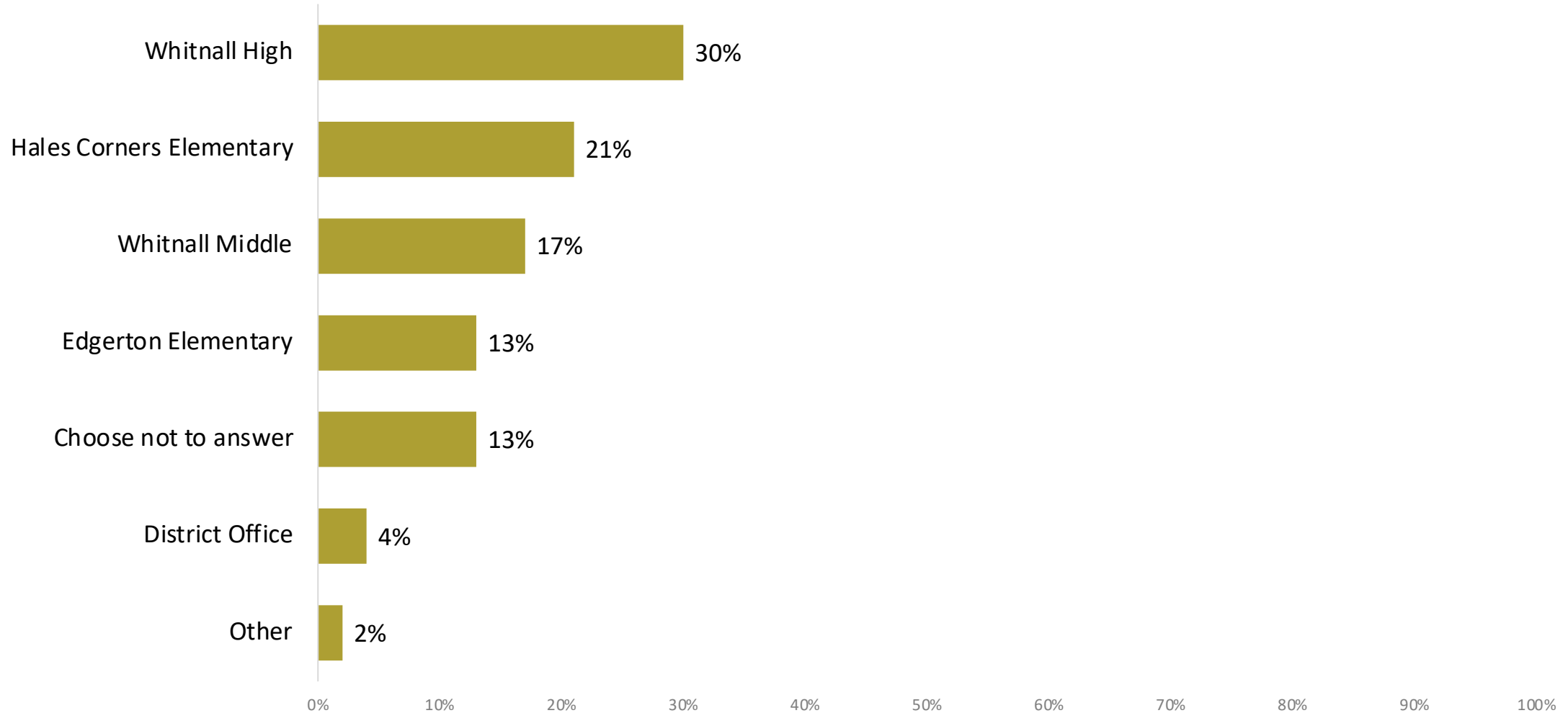
# What best describes your position?

# Background

# Question-Level Data Information



- Percent “Agree” and “Strongly agree” and average scores are shown for each question.
  - Data is further disaggregated by three key subgroups: staff, parents/caregivers, and non-parents/non-staff (NP/NS).
- Average are calculated based on the following weights
  - Strongly agree = 5
  - Agree = 4
  - Disagree = 2
  - Strongly disagree = 1
  - Those responding “Don’t know” or “Doesn’t apply” are not included in the calculations.
- Items are in descending order from highest agreement to lowest agreement based on all respondents.

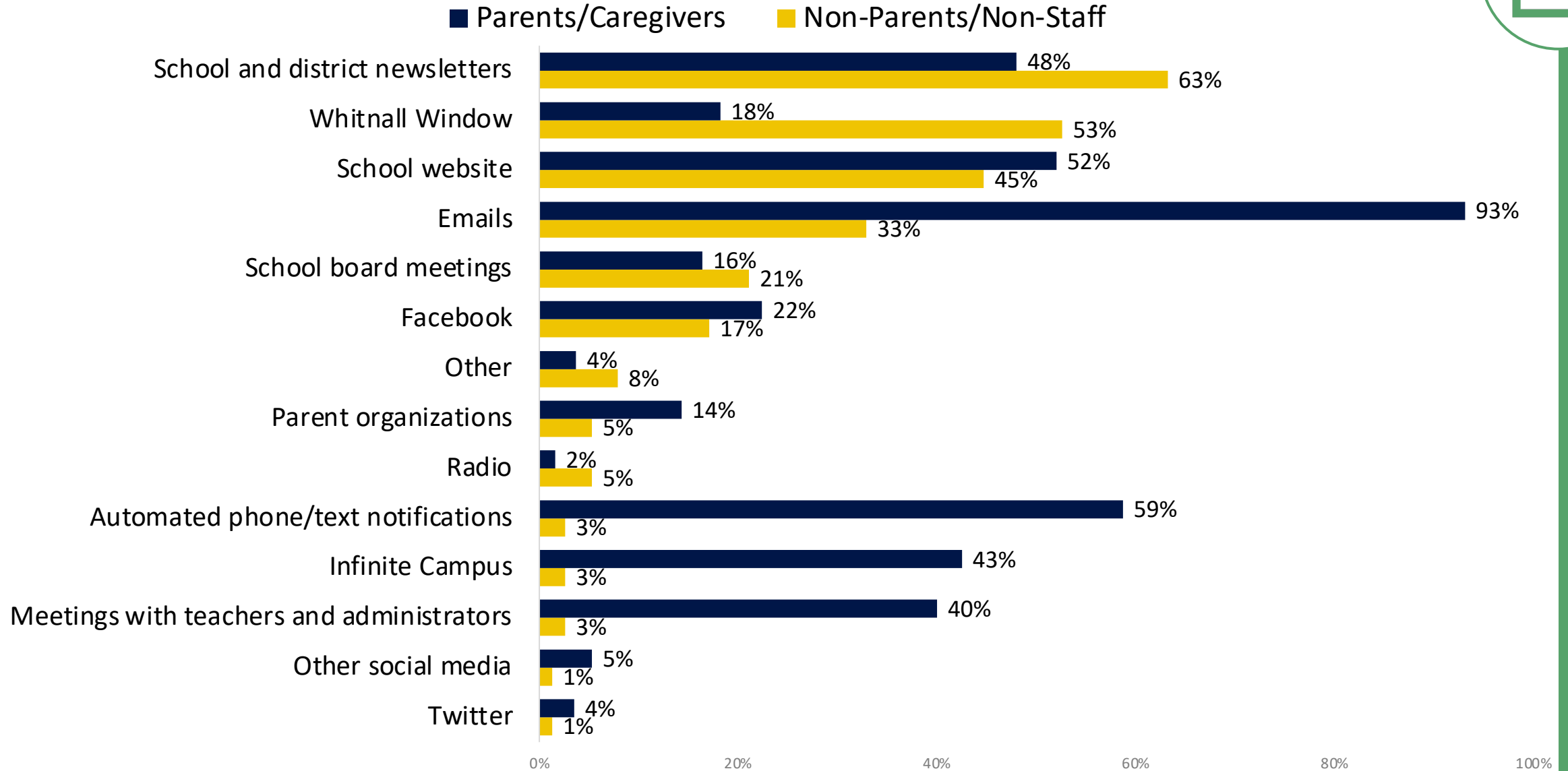

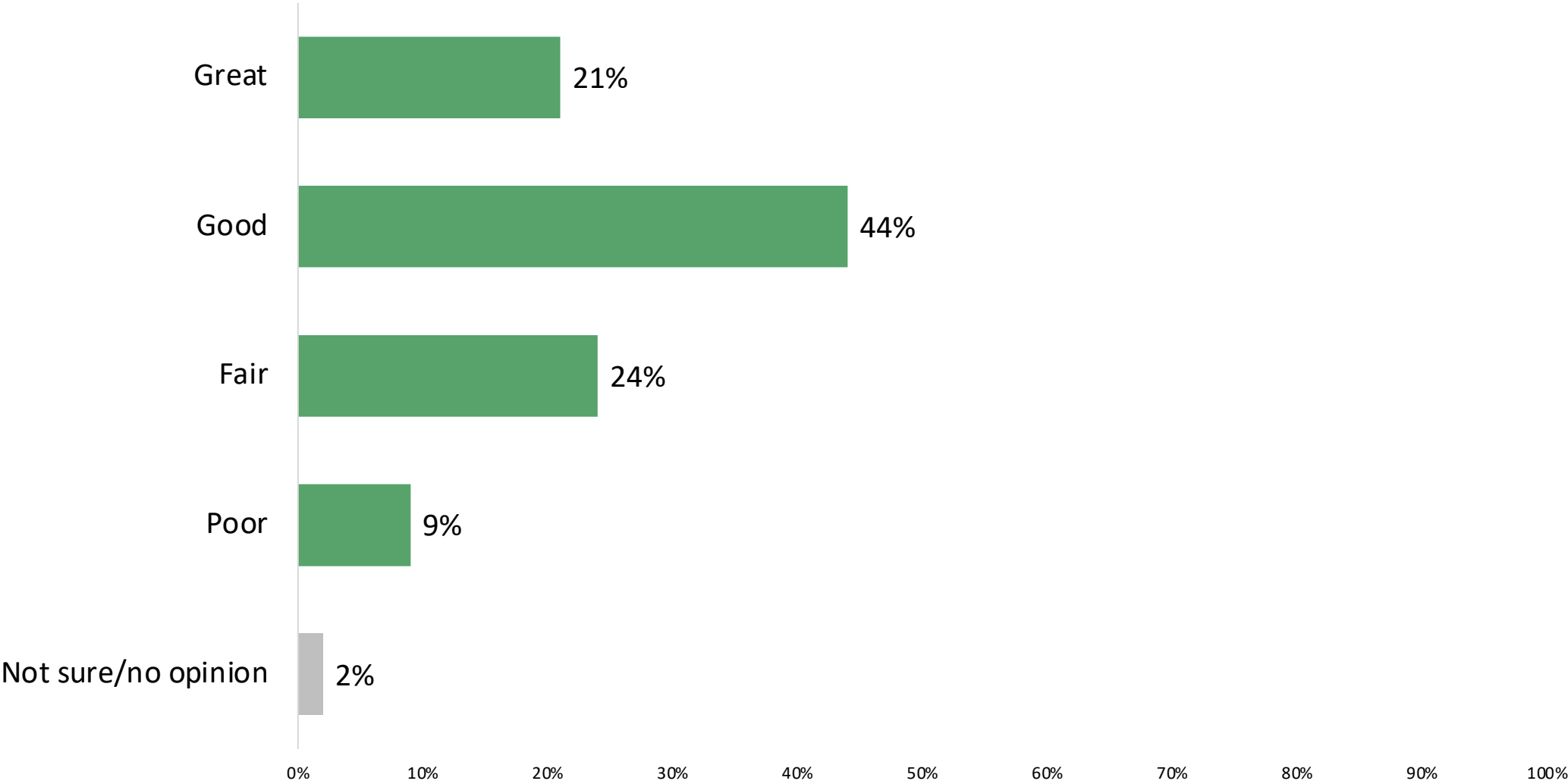

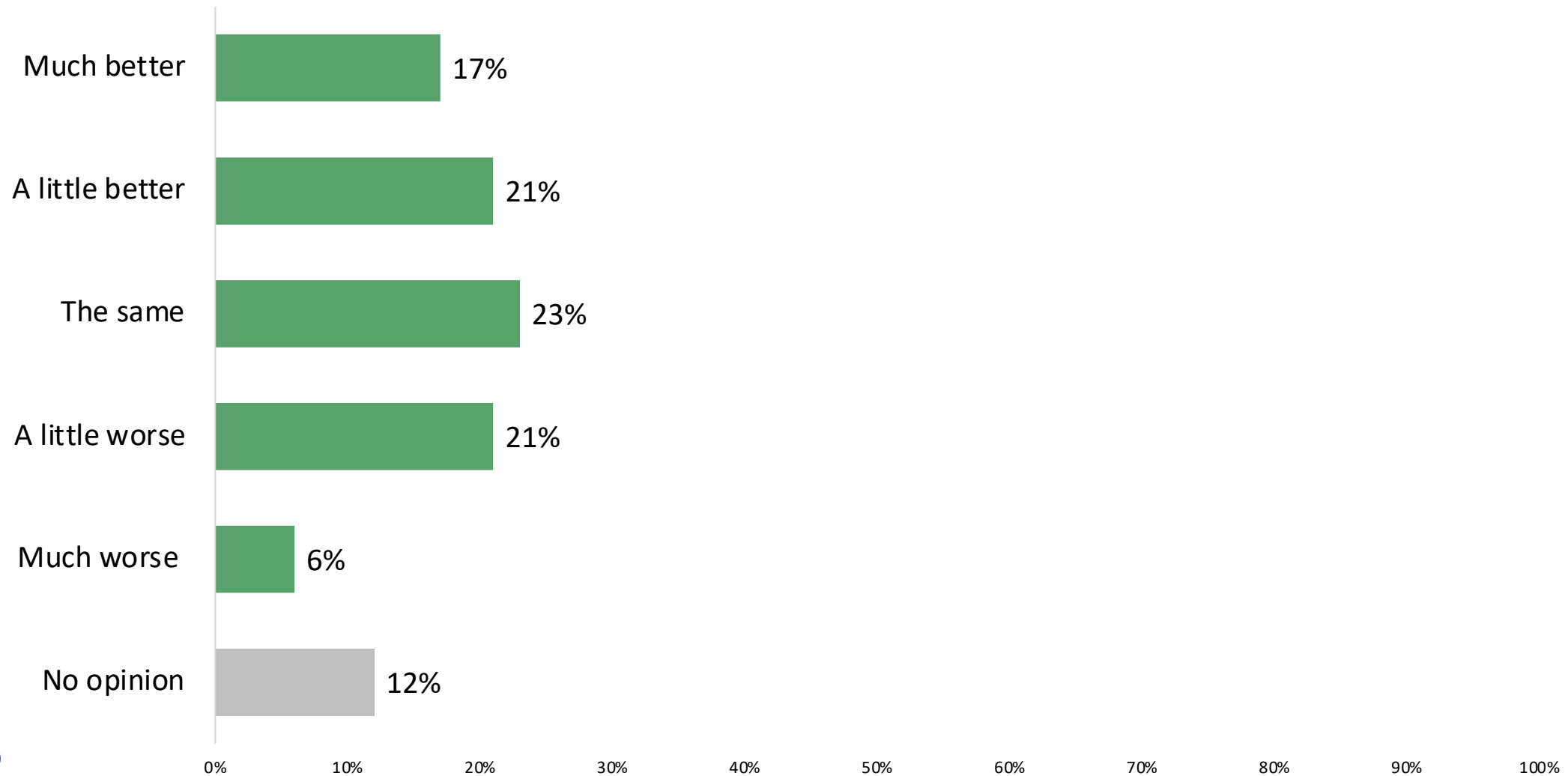
# How do you like to receive school/District information? *(Mark all that apply.)*



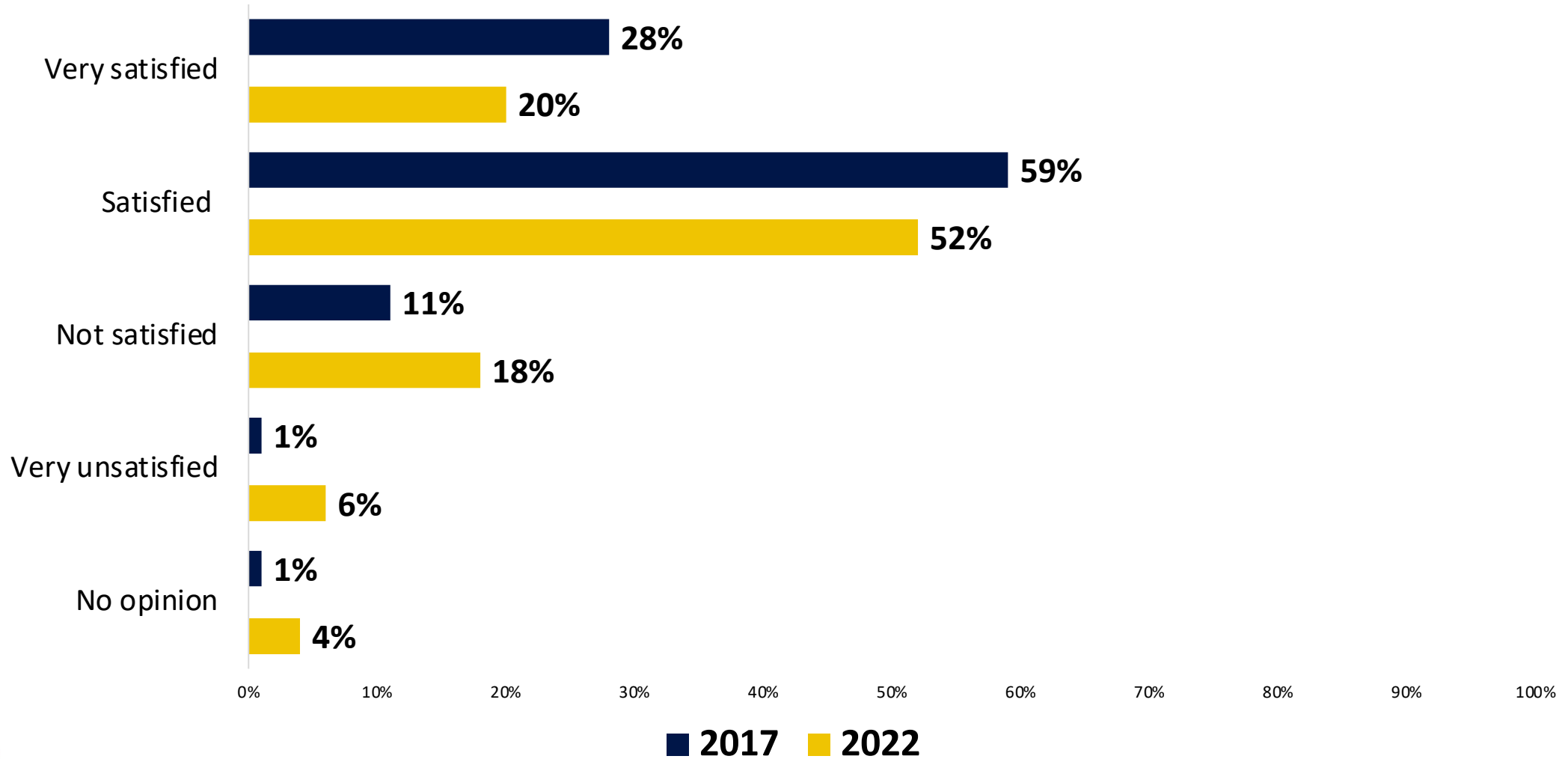
# Overall, how would you rate communications from the school?

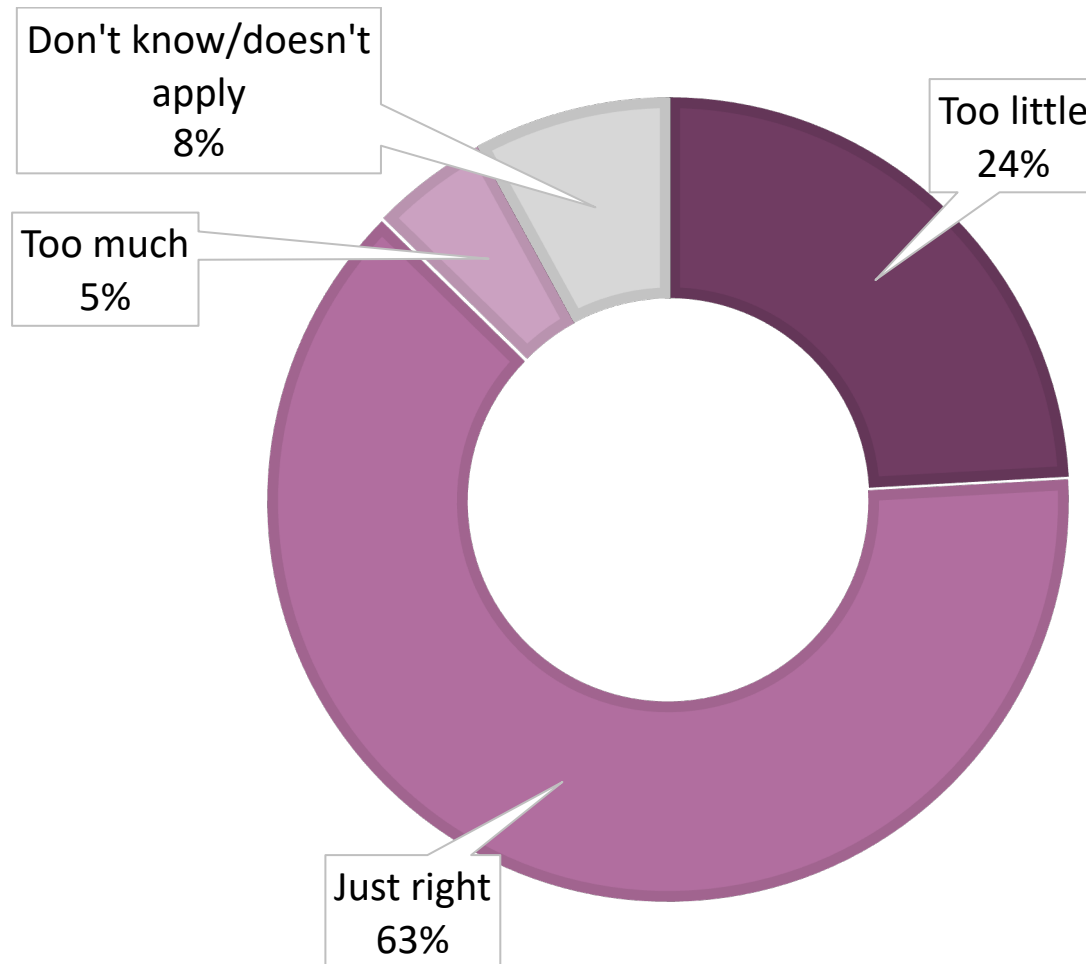

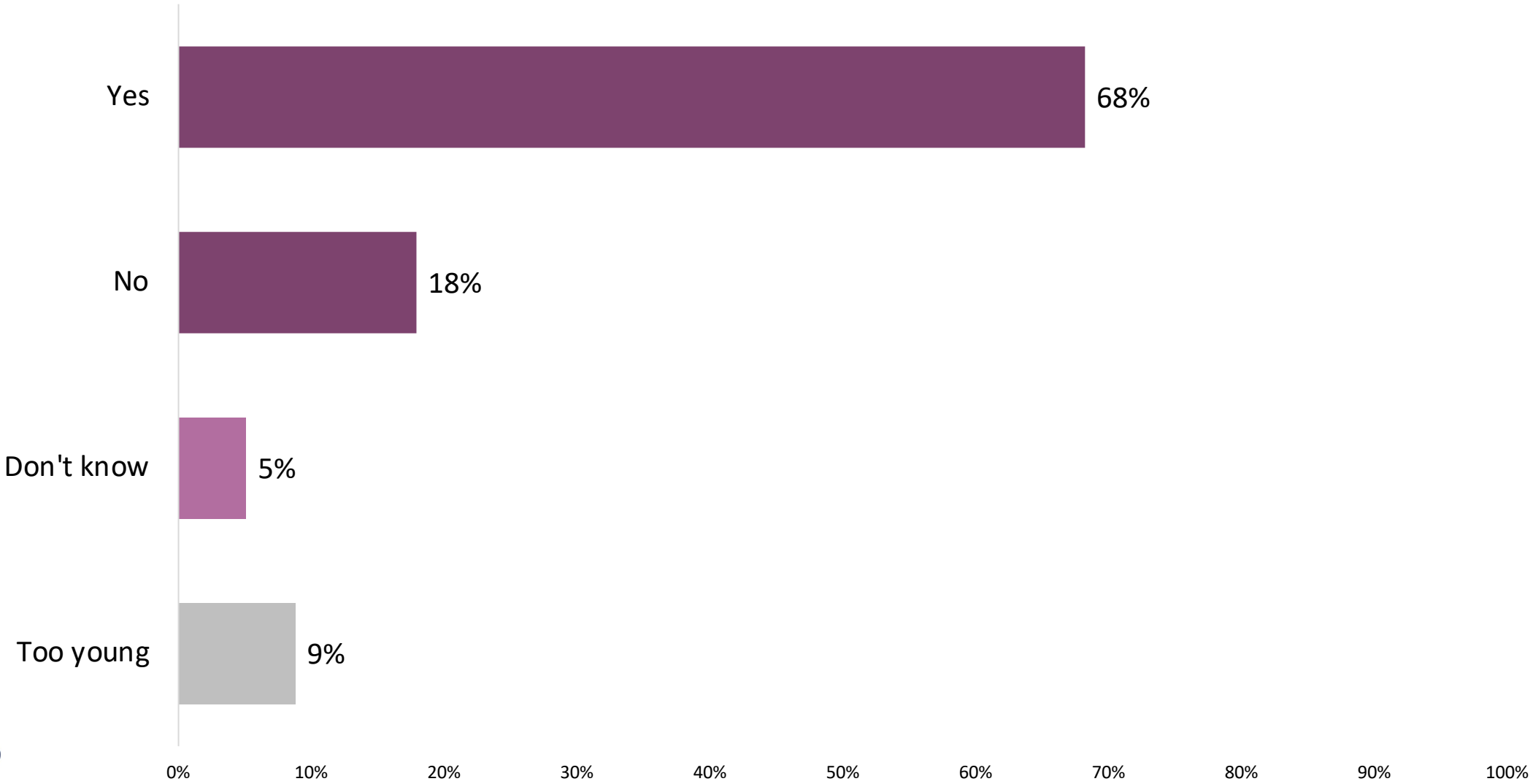

# The overall amount of homework my child is asked to complete outside of school is:

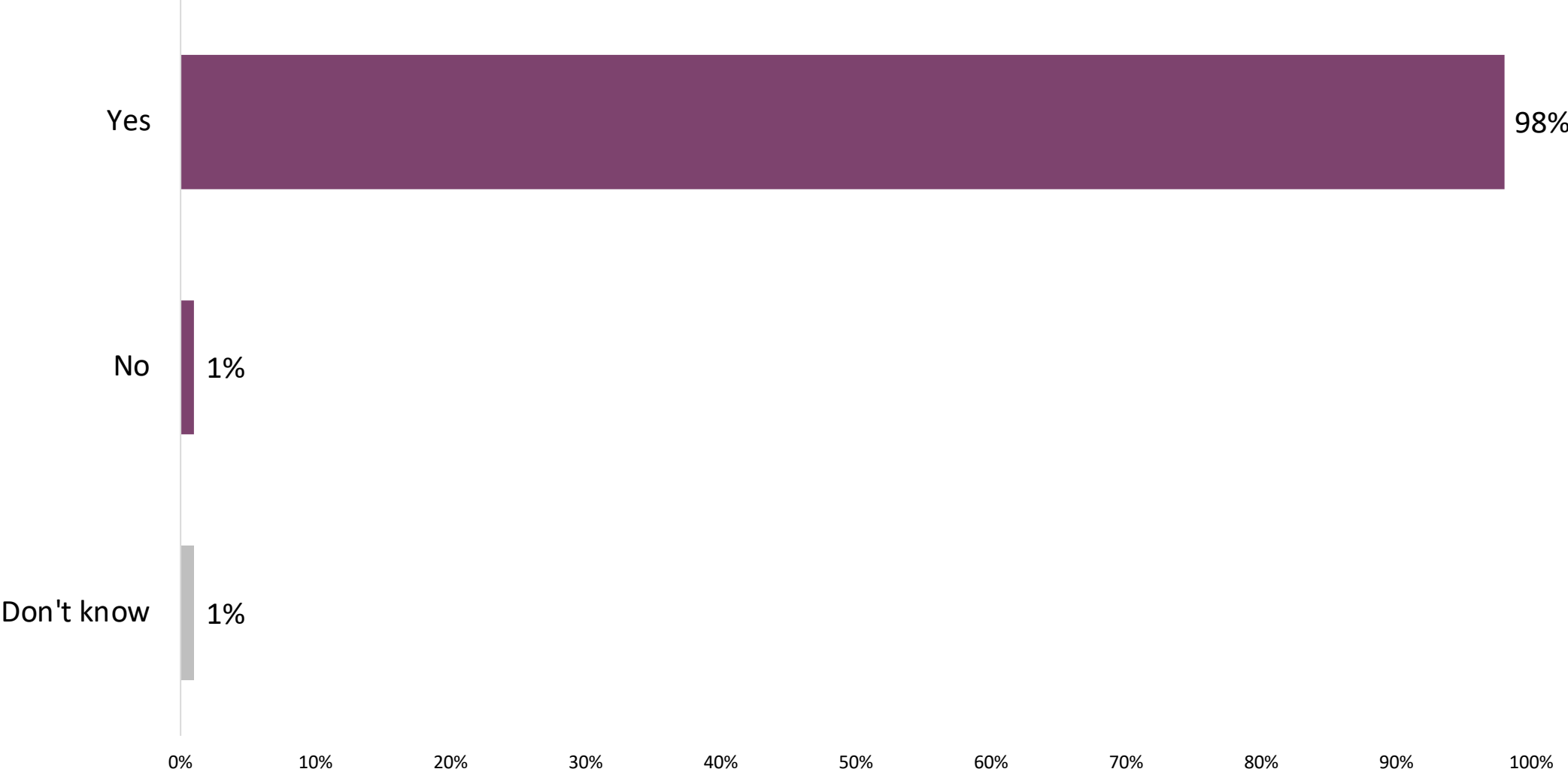


# Does your child currently participate or plan to participate in any school-sponsored sports and/or extracurricular activities?

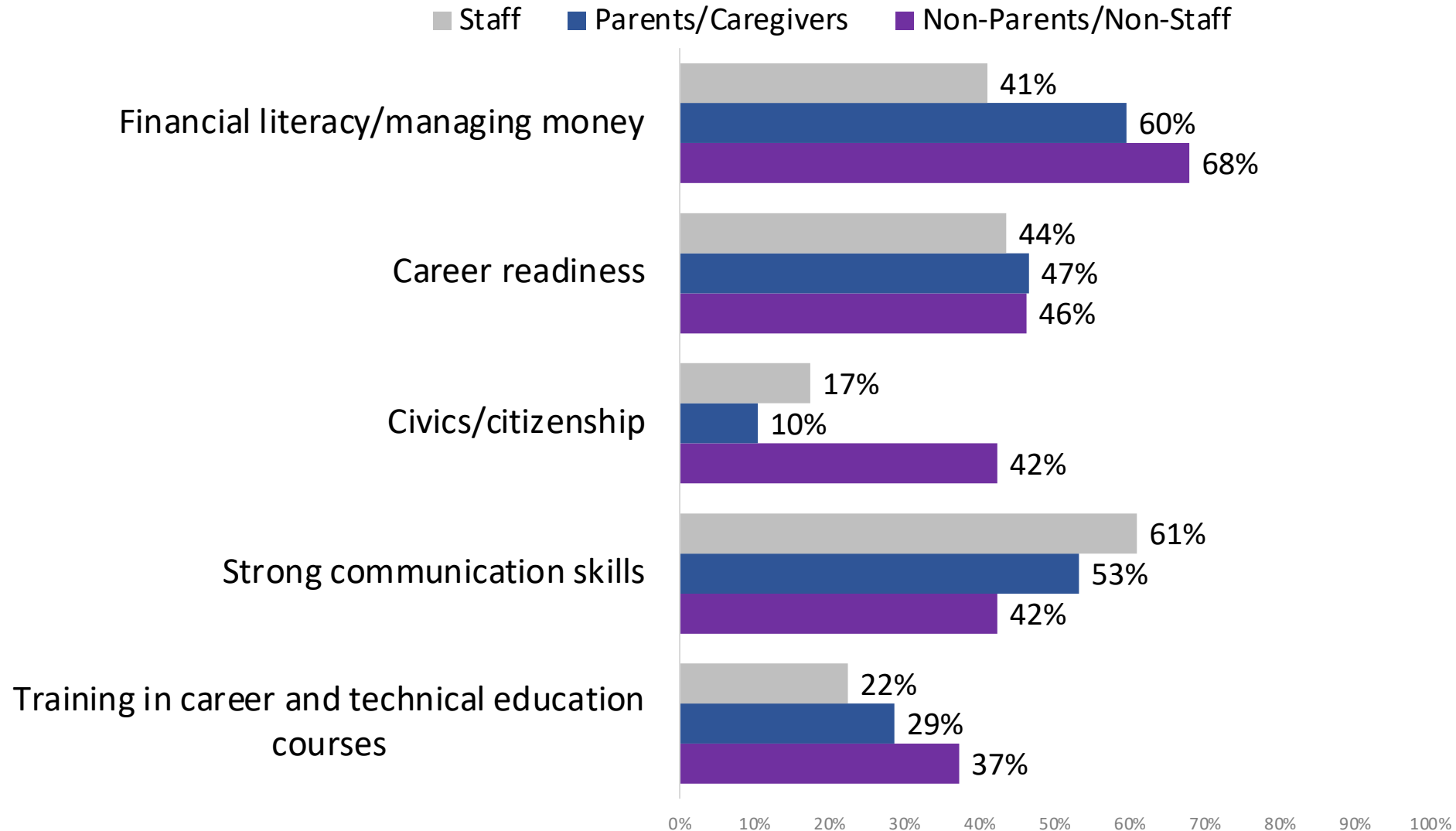

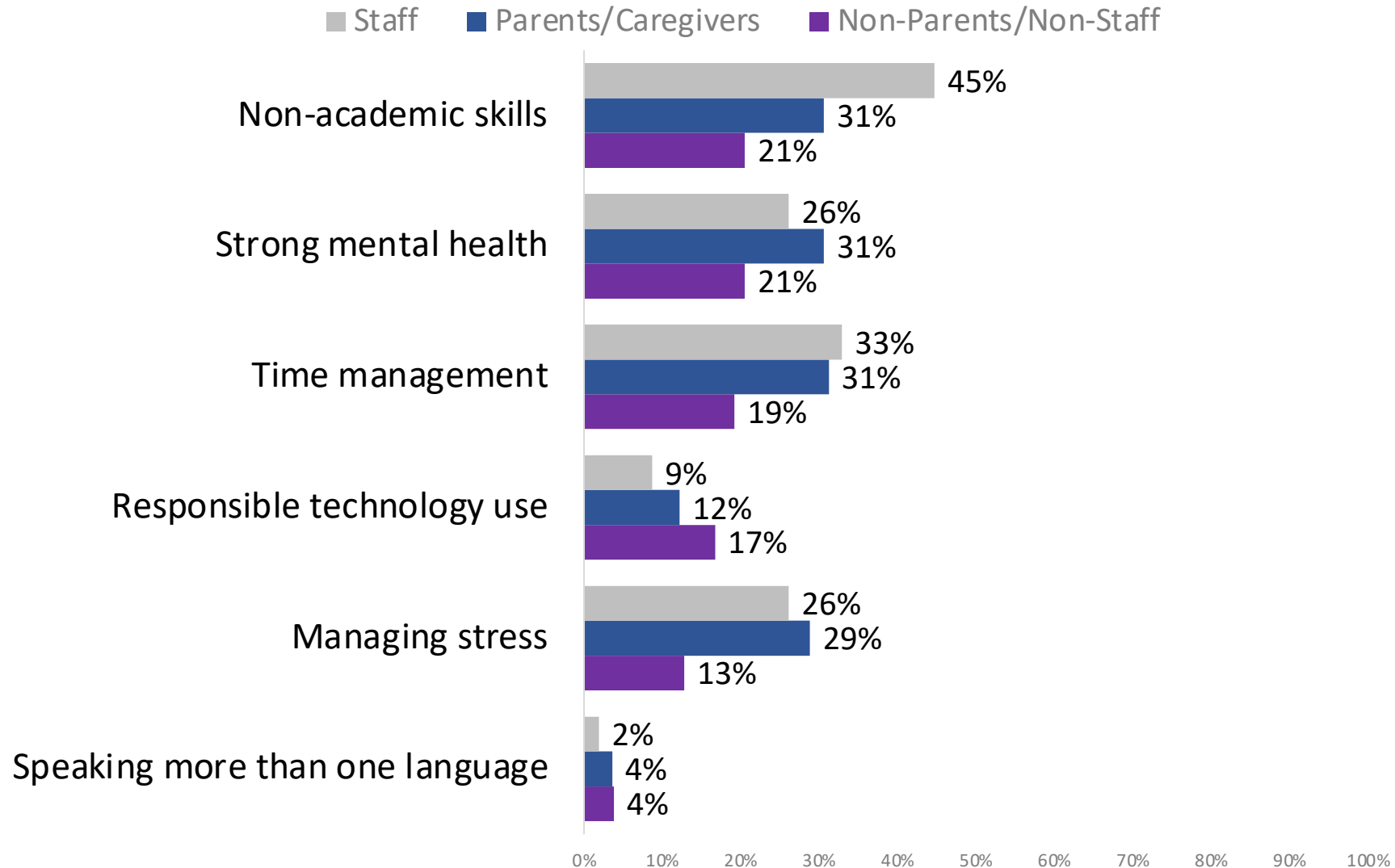

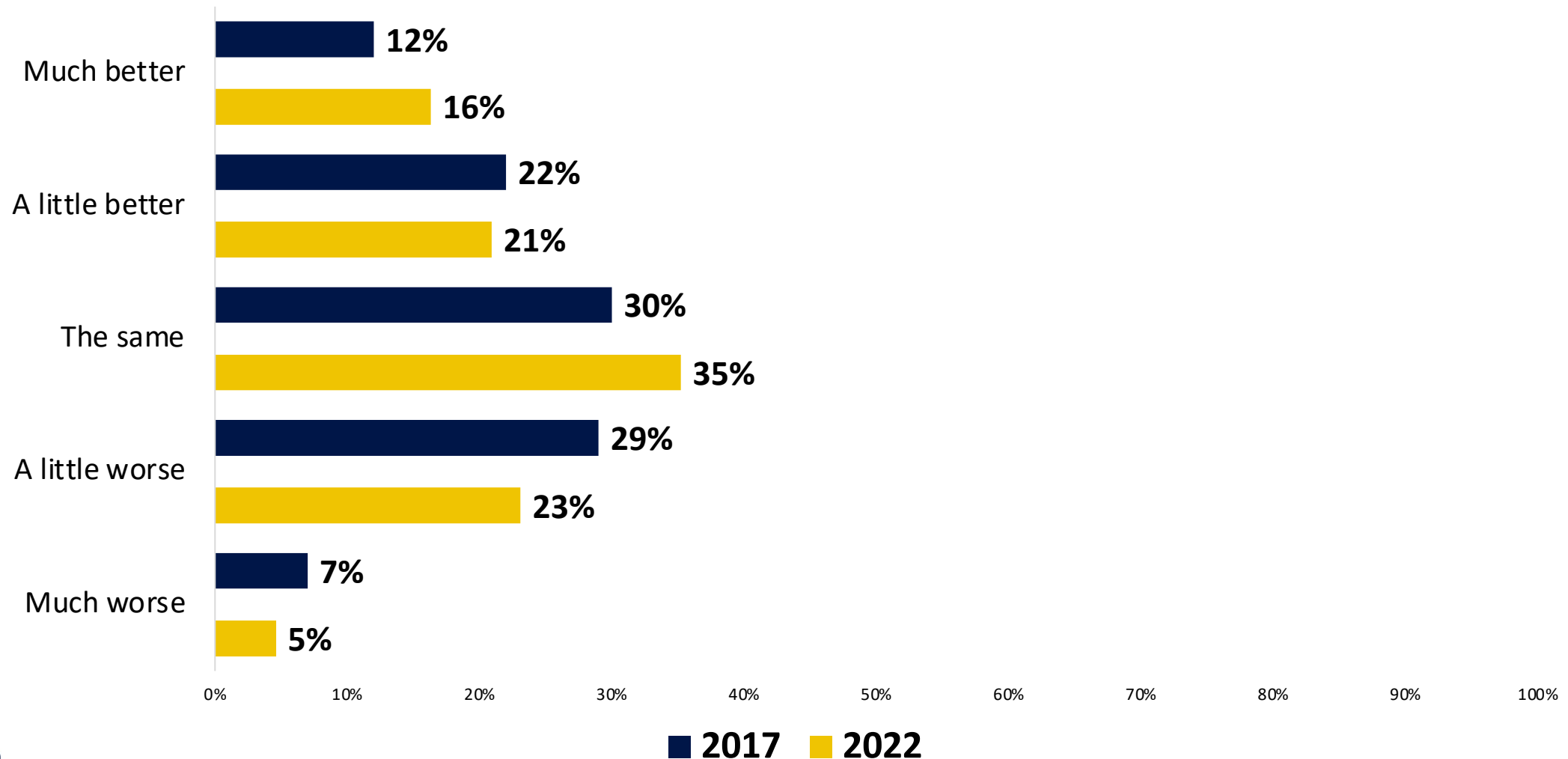

Therefore, if everyone one selected *Great*, the score = 4.0.

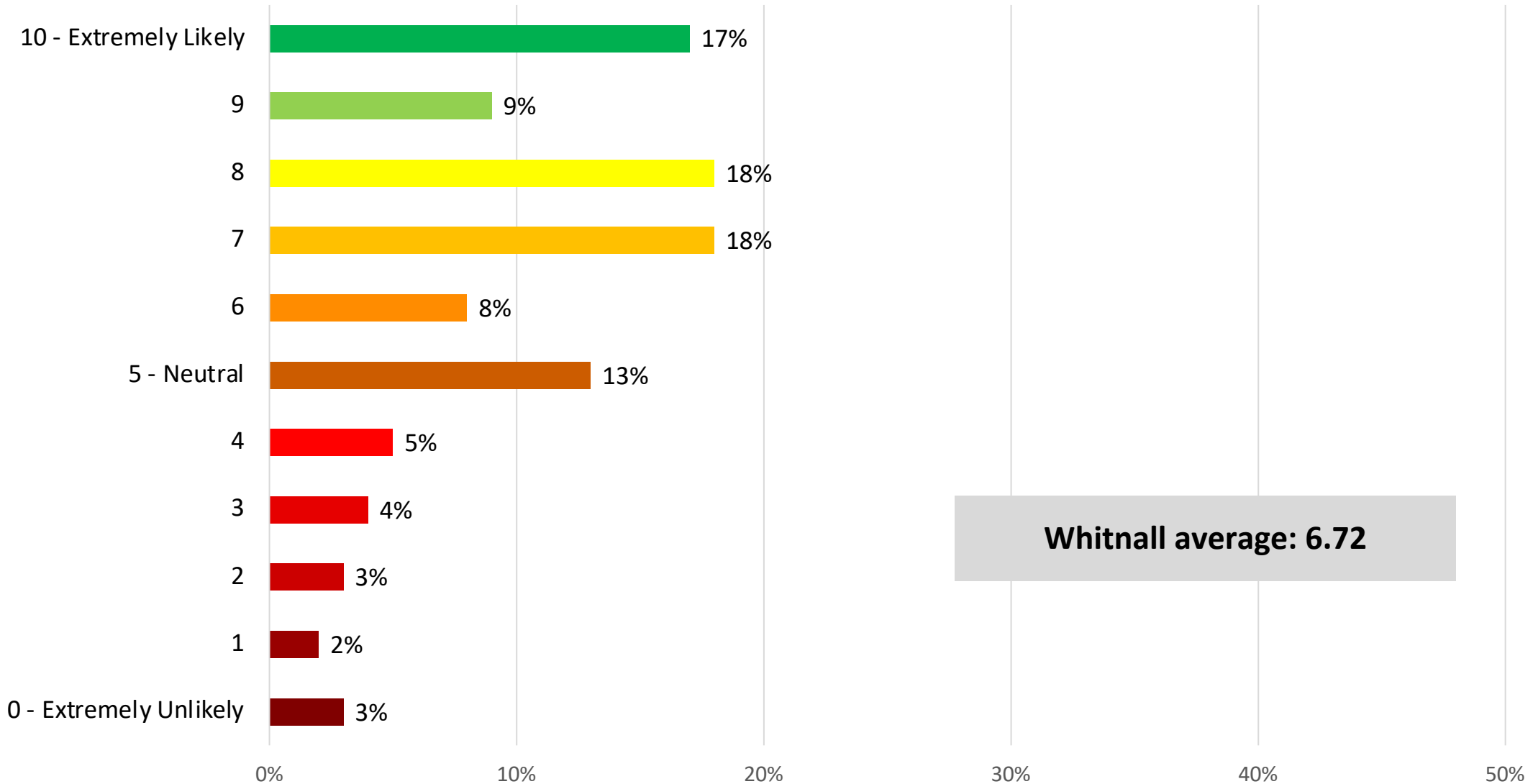
