HOW DO I BECOME A LIFEGUARD?

Requirements:

- At least 16 years old and older
- Swim 100 meters in 1 minute 45 seconds

Training Program:

1. Attend one of the FREE in water training sessions. For dates, times and locations, visit our website at: **MKEswim.com**
 - 12 Hour In-Water Training
2. Take and pass physical performance test based on skills learned at in water training.
3. Complete and pass advanced first aid and CPR course in the spring.
 - 40 Hour Class
 - Paid for taking the training
4. If hired and assigned to a location, learn and demonstrate site specific policies and procedures.

2024 Pay Rate

- 1st Year: \$16.80
- 2nd Year: \$17.53
- 3rd Year: \$18.28

ASSIGNMENTS

Assignments are made to all aquatic centers, beaches, and pools operated by Milwaukee County Parks.

Individuals are ranked based on the score they achieve at the physical performance test after completing the in-water training program.

Individuals can choose 5 locations they would accept. Assignments are not guaranteed from this list. If applicable, candidate can list 5 locations they will not accept.

Each location has a specific number of lifeguards, based on year, that are assigned.

Working Conditions

The Milwaukee County Lifeguard Corps season is from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Assignments are based on FULL TIME AVAILABILITY to work 6-8 hours a day 5-7 days a week with no restrictions.

Milwaukee County Lifeguard Corps will work with individuals with part time or restricted availability on a one on one basis. Employment is not guaranteed.
